

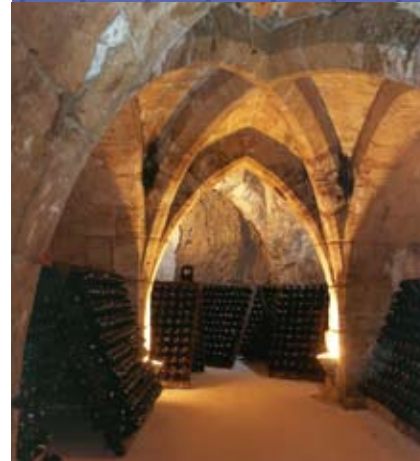
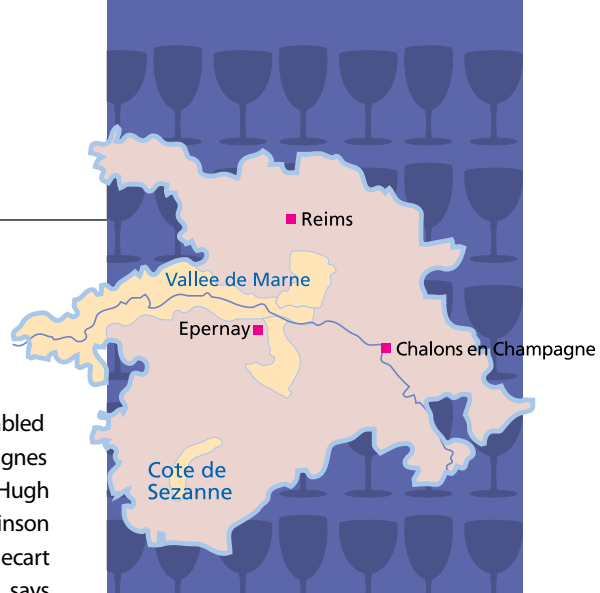
CHAMPAGNE

BILLECART-SALMON

Not only wine book authors, but television wine presenters, trade wine magazines and Denis Lillie etc. all regard Billecart-Salmon as THE champagne producer. In 1999, more than 150 wine experts met to choose the best champagnes made since 1945. Cristal, Vintage Krug, Dom Perignon were the favourites. The assembled multitude chose two Billecart vintages as first and second. Why? Their champagnes manage to combine purity, elegance, creaminess and depth of flavour. To quote Hugh Johnson's 'Pocket Book of Wine' an exemplary Champagne House' or Jancis Robinson 'I tasted eighteen Non-Vintage Champagnes from famous houses last week and Billecart-Salmon was the most impressive'. The bible on Champagne by Tom Stevenson says 'Billecart-Salmon offers one of the strongest ranges of high-quality champagnes available'. 20% of Billecart's production makes Rosé. The Billecart Vintage and Non Vintage Rosé are rated the best worldwide. The Times advised lovers to choose the Non-Vintage on Valentine's Day. The presence of Billecart-Salmon on an establishment's list has been described as 'a sure indicator of the management's approach to quality'. We are glad to list them.

MONTAUDON

The influential Wine Spectator magazine scored the Montaudon Reserve Premier Brut first at a tasting which included most major champagne houses' non-vintage wines (but not Billecart). This left Roederer, Pol Roger and Moët behind. The wines are noted for their more full-bodied and toasty style. Demi-Sec is effectively a medium dry Champagne and can prove popular with customers looking to avoid a bone dry finish.



VINTAGE CHAMPAGNES



Bollinger La Grande Année

Mostly made from Pinot Noir which generally gives the wine that full-bodied flavour.

Billecart-Salmon Cuvée NFB

A palate piled high with fruit balanced by excellent acidity to ensure that it lasts for a long time.



Billecart-Salmon Blanc de Blancs Brut

This retains Billecart's exceptional creaminess with great freshness and developed nutty and toasty overtones. Twice voted the best Champagne served on first class airlines.

Dom Perignon

Did this famous monk invent Champagne or not? Whatever, the champagne bearing his name is one of the region's best.

Krug Grande Prestige Cuvée Brut

Strictly this is a Krug, as the price suggests, undoubtedly a top producer of a rich, fruity but elegant wine. The vintage wine is available on application.

Louis Roederer Cristal Brut

A very famous but truly wonderful Champagne produced in maddeningly small quantities is magnificent with ten years' age in bottle but who can wait?

Billecart-Salmon Cuvée Elizabeth Salmon Rosé

Possibly the finest pink Champagne available given Billecart's reputation and expertise with rosé. Extremely elegant and stylish raspberries and cream, the flavour of which goes on and on.

Veuve Clicquot Rosé NV Credited as the first Champagne house to produce rosé, this has lots of summer fruits character.
