



GERMANY

Quality wines from Germany into the U.K. over recent years have suffered from the perception that the consumer does not want to pay high prices for them. As a result, whilst Liebfraumilch from the Rheinhessen and Piesporter from the Mosel have still remained popular, they have been overtaken by other wine producing countries who are making wines that are drier, higher in alcohol and have more weight of fruit and complexity of flavour.

Nevertheless, the light, fruity and flowery style of these wines still remain popular with many of our customers. Three years ago we added a straight Riesling from the Rheinpfalz region that displays fresh, vibrant characteristics with a delicate effervescence and a lovely clean finish – this goes really well with Asian foods.
